1. Request Council Approval to award Maggolg, Inc. for the NW 62 Avenue Roadway Improvement Project

Mayor Deno reported that three bids were provided for the NW 62 Avenue Roadway Improvement Project.

The bids were as follows:

Maggolg, Inc. - \$258,900.00
JVA - \$587,016.51
Re State - \$298,321.00

Mayor Deno reported that Maggolg, Inc. was the lowest bidder and stated that Maggolg, Inc. had completed the NW 38 St and NW 64 Ave project. Mayor Deno also stated that JVA had completed the NW 62 Ave and 40 Street project. Council Member Fernandez stated that the

Village needs to make sure the project is not subbed out by Maggoc, Inc. and mentioned that JVA's bid was double the price even though their quality of work is better. Mayor Deno reported that Re State was not known to the Village.

A motion by Council Member Taylor Martinez to award the NW 62 Avenue Roadway Improvement Project to Maggoc, Inc. was seconded by Council Member Conover. The motion was approved 5-0.
