#### 10. Mayor's Report

The mayor invited Jason Neal from Waste Management to present the terms for the contract renewal, effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024

Jason Neil from Waste Management is offering the Village of Virginia Gardens the following terms;

- A service rate of \$30.50 per home
- The village currently has two rate adjustments every year. We receive a
   (CPI) every January and a disposal increase every October. The new
   proposal eliminates the disposal increase and applies a CPI every January
   that will be capped at 8%.
- Waste Management has also requested replacing residents' bins when broken instead of the City having to buy new ones.
- Services remain the same: twice a week at the curve and quarterly bulk collection.

Jason Neil states that new rates will still provide Virginia Gardens a favorable rate, significantly lower than the most comparable local municipality.

A motion to direct the Mayor and Administration to prepare a contract for consideration with terms presented before the Council by Waste Management. Made by Council Member Block, Member Council Conover seconded it. The motion passed 5-0
